Hennepin County has redesigned their streets and hybrid basemaps! In addition to the new look and feel, several layers have been added to enhance the user experience, including boundaries and roads

beyond Hennepin County borders, hillshade relief, building footprints (downtown Minneapolis and Hennepin County facilities), skyways, major trails, airports, and light rail.
